WHO CAN JOIN?

Any child between the ages of six months-three year olds.

WHAT WE ASK:

That you volunteer your time to work in the nursery! Our volunteer schedule is on a rotational basis. The more participants, the less we ask you to volunteer. Spread the word about this great ministry!

Once enrolled, we will add you to our online sign up system. Periodically, we will create new sign-up sheets. At that time, you will be emailed with a link to sign up. We ask that you volunteer for one or two volunteer slots per sign-up sheet. The nursery chairperson will give you more specific instructions when the sign-up sheet is issued.

Diapers, wipes, juice/water cup, and a lovie/pacifier, or anything to help your child feel comfortable. If your child is toilet-trained, please let us know so we can remind him/her to use the restroom.

Snacks such as goldfish, cheerios, or animal crackers will be served. Please let us know if your child has any food allergies.
