Dear Friends,

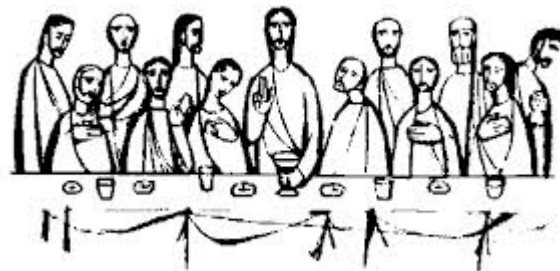

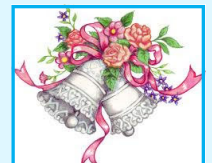
