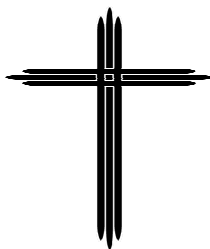

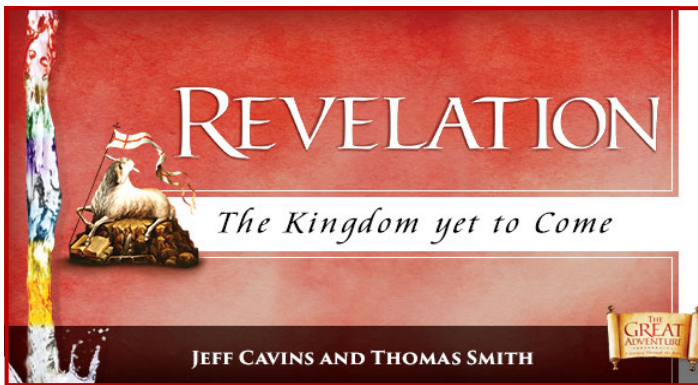

**Prime Timers Potluck Luncheon**



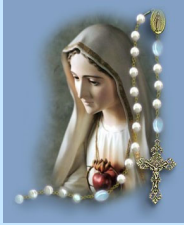
